
Nom détaillé de la ressource BRNE utilisée : article de presse « Marvellous Roald Dahl »

Cet article est disponible dans le Médiacentre de l'espace CDI de l'ENT de l'établissement : Banque de Ressources-Nathan Speakeasy-Anglais cycle 4.

L'article se trouve dans le module nommé « Ressources numériques et activités – Anglais – C4 ».

Une fois dans le module, cliquez sur « Articles de presse », faites défiler les articles jusque ceux de niveau B1, puis cliquez sur « Culture et création artistiques > B1 ».

L'article sur Roald Dahl est classé dans le dossier 2016 et s'intitule « Marvellous Roald Dahl ».



### Modalité :

Mes élèves de 3ème lisent un roman de Roald Dahl dans le cadre d'un défi lecture inter-établissements que je propose tous les ans. Il peut s'agir d'Esio Trot (version intégrale), de Matilda (version adaptée à des apprenants étrangers) ou de Charlie and the chocolate factory (version adaptée).

La BRNE anglais cycle 4 leur permet de découvrir qui était Roald Dahl et de s'entraîner à la compréhension de l'écrit grâce aux activités proposées.

Voici un extrait de l'article en question.

Une aide lexicale est proposée aux élèves, si besoin. Ici, l'élève a passé la souris sur « oil company » pour obtenir une définition dans la langue cible.

Un enregistrement audio est proposé à la fin de l'article.

After school, Roald Dahl worked for an **oil company** in Africa. He chose the job because he was fond of flying. (exp): a company that extracts petrol and sells it for use in cars, industry, etc. and was in hospital for six months. He had to stop flying, and went to Washington, D.C., as a diplomat. He started writing about his war experiences, but soon began writing short stories and films.

Dahl's children's books are classics and there are many film and theatre adaptations. Do you know *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, *Matilda*, *Fantastic Mr Fox* or *The BFG (Big Friendly Giant)*? Dahl's children's books are not sentimental – sometimes they are macabre, with adult **villains!** The children often have difficulties – they are **poor**, have no parents or have horrible parents. The books have lots of humour, fantasy and magic.

#### • A Writer's Life

Roald Dahl was born 13 September, 1916 in Wales, United Kingdom. His parents were Norwegian. His father went to Wales for his **business**. Roald Dahl was a writer and poet. He was also a film and TV writer. And he was a military pilot in *World War Two*. He died on 23 November, 1990.

Roald Dahl used elements of his life in his books. He went to boarding school and had some horrible and bizarre teachers who appear as characters in his books. At **boarding school** the boys tested chocolate bars for a chocolate factory...

#### • Roald Dahl Day

On 13 September, Roald Dahl's birthday, fans of his stories wear costumes of their favourite **characters**. Do you know them? Who is your favourite character?
